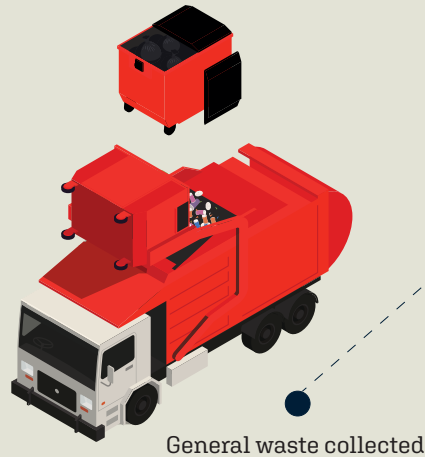
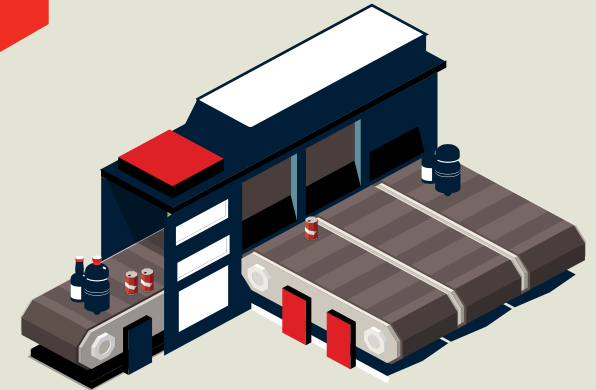
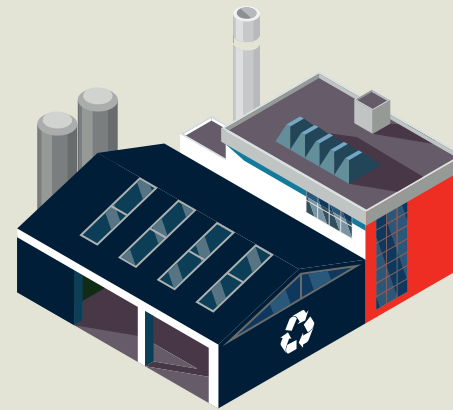


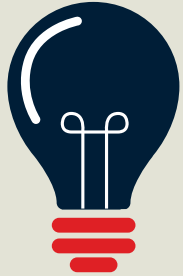
RDF Energy



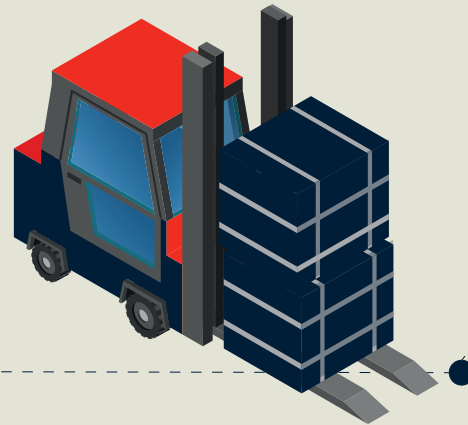
Waste is transferred to one of our advanced processing plants



Here waste is segregated, processed and decontaminated to ensure that as much recyclable material as possible is extracted



Typically, just seven tonnes of RDF will provide enough power for an average house for a year



To create RDF, materials undergo a processing that includes screening, cleaning, baling and then wrapping. These bales are then delivered to an Energy From Waste facility where they're converted into power.

For residential waste there are two options, Landfill or energy recovery. To avoid sending waste to landfill we convert it into Solid Recovered Fuels (SRF) and Refuse Derived Fuels (RDF)
